

Notation and Terminology for the Job Market

This document defines terms and notation used in the other job market documents.

Item	Explanation
Moniker	- Your database username, used for naming CV, Abstract, etc. It MUST be LastnameFirstinitialMiddleinitial I will sometimes refer to this, for short, as Moniker NO SPACES ALLOWED; e.g. Pierangelo De Pace is DePaceP For me it would be CarrollCD If I didn't have a middle name, my moniker would be CarrollC Getting capitalization right is important - don't be sloppy
JMCC	- Job Market Computer Coordinator is the person responsible for nitty-gritty computer tasks
JMPO	- Job Market Placement Officer is the faculty member coordinating the overall placement process
JOE	- Job Openings for Economists online job postings used by most U.S. and many other employers
job market directory	- Directory on <code>server.econ.jhu.edu/jobmarket/[year]/[Moniker]</code> that will contain your CV, abstract, etc
Acorn	- The package of materials (CV, Abstract, etc) you send to employers
T	- Thanksgiving day
T _{-3d}	- 3 Days before Thanksgiving day
T _{-1w}	- 1 Week before Thanksgiving day
T _{-1m}	- 1 Month before Thanksgiving day
A	- Date of ASSA meetings (with similar timing conventions)
P	- Sending date of JHU Packet of CV's and abstracts
