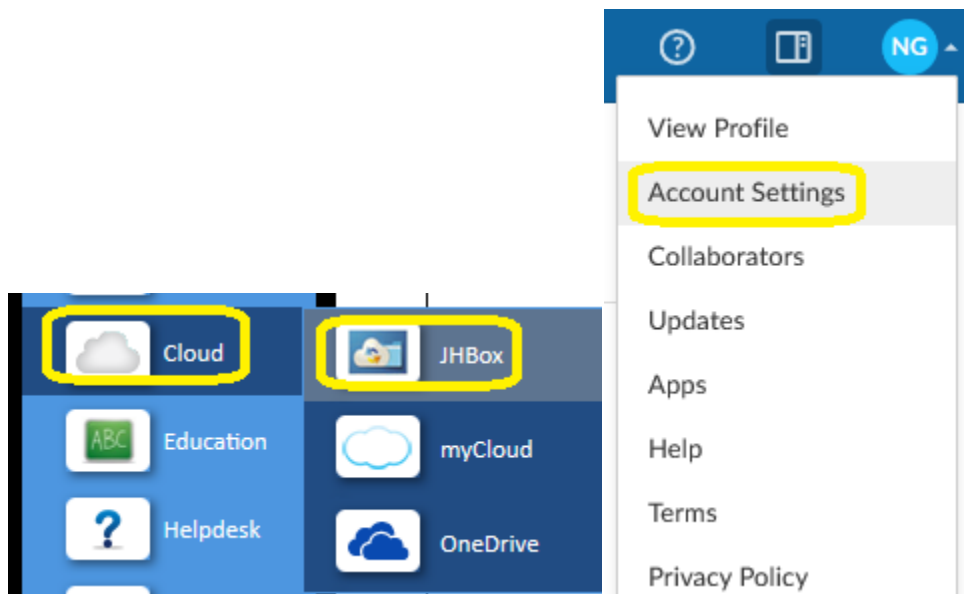




Connecting to JHBOX and Mounting JHBOX as a volume/network drive

1. You can connect to JHBox to upload, download and share files using any browser on a PC, MAC or Linux.
Log in to the Hopkins Portal at my.jh.edu and then go to "Cloud">"JHBox".
2. To mount JhBox as a volume/network drive you need to create an external box password using "add network folder" on a PC, or "Connect to server" on a mac or linux. You can create an external password after logging in to jhbox through the Hopkins portal. It's under "Cloud">"JHBox". Then go to "Account Settings" and "Authentication". This password should be different than your JHED_ID one.



Authentication

Because you are using Single Sign On (SSO), you will need to create a unique password to use external applications that do not support SSO.

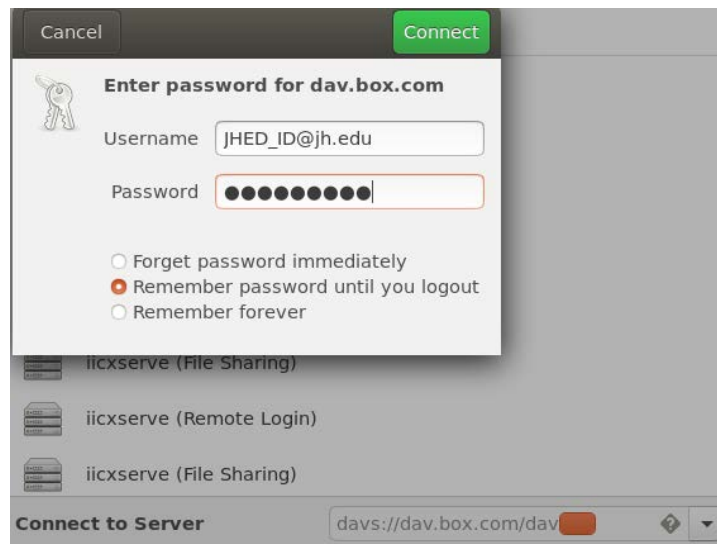
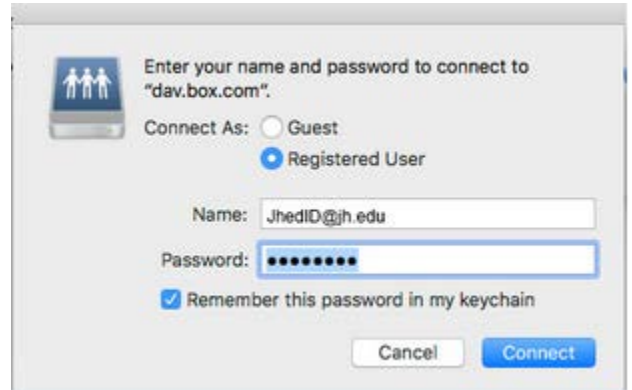
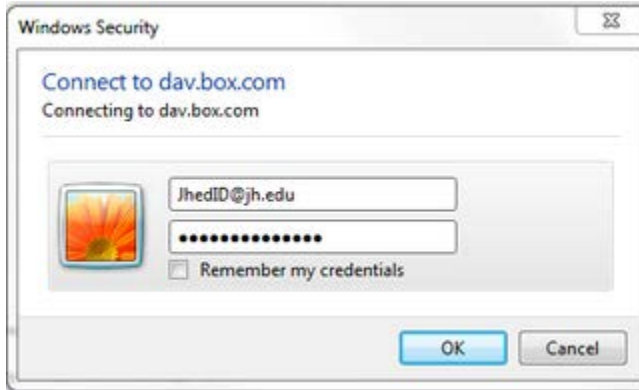

3. The server address to connect to from a PC or a Mac is: <https://dav.box.com/dav>; for Linux use `davs://dav.box.com/dav`.

4. Login using JhedID@jh.edu and the external password you set earlier.



5. You will see **dav.box.com** as a mounted volume.
